



Clinical Supervisor for wider workforce Course Programme

This is a course for General Practitioners, nurses and allied health professionals working at Advance Clinical Practice level, who wish to clinically supervise the wider workforce in a Primary Care learning environment.

In the current climate we are having to move away from face to face meetings and need to try a blended online approach with some preparation work.

Participants will need to work in a GP practice and have their practice approved as an educational environment.

Structure of the course

The course will be run over two separate days with some inter-modular work. It is essential that both modules are attended and completed.

Objectives

By the end of the course the participant will: -

- Have a clear understanding of the role of a clinical supervisor and the primary health care team in learning and supervision
- Have knowledge of the curricula of the persons they wish to supervise and how to identify their learning needs.
- Be able to structure a teaching session for a learner and be aware of basic methods of teaching
- Be able to teach and assess communication skills within the workplace
- Understand the assessments that may be required how to complete them
- Have developed their own personal learning plan related to their role as a supervisor
