NHS England's General Practice Fellowship scheme is designed to support newly qualified GPs, including those working less than full time to transition from training to an employed member of the primary care team. The programme will help practices and PCNs to recruit and retain GPs by offering attractive roles that lead to long term employment in practice, providing experience within a supportive environment.

The Greater Manchester Training Hub invite newly qualified doctors and employers to participate in the scheme.

GM Fellowship is a structured, supportive programme to ensure doctors have the best possible experience of General Practice following qualification.

- **Eligibility:**
- Hold a substantive Salaried or Partner role
- Delivering GMS services
- Newly qualified or qualified within last 12 months

Fellowship Framework:

- 2 year programme
- CPD funding reimbursement of 1 session per week based on full time, 9 sessions (4hr 10min/52 weeks)
- **Phase 1:** Induction, Peer support, Mentorship and coaching
- **Phase 2:** Learning and Development
- **Phase 3:** PCN Portfolio working

All phases will be supported and in some cases delivered through the Training Hub: please note elements of this programme can be accessed by HEE fellows
