### Description

The GP PA Ready Programme is designed to support and further develop the fundamental knowledge, skills, and experience required to confidently and competently work within the primary care environment. The course is written against the RCGP curriculum and competency framework to develop the individual's skills of consultation; shared decision making, and management of uncertainty and complexity in general practice.

### Expectations

The expectation is that individuals on the preceptorship will attend at least 80% of the taught sessions with maximum engagement. The programme is blended learning from case-based approach to specialist presentations, and so individuals will be expected to bring cases from their own practice to discuss within the group. This may also include pre-reading with resources sent out in advance to ensure for optimal learning during each session.
